## **HIGHLIGHTS OF ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT CALENDAR YEAR 2014**

Hereunder are the highlights of our Agency's accomplishments for CY 2014:

### **I. ON THE OPERATION OF THE REGIONAL FISH PORT COMPLEXES AND MUNICIPAL FISH PORTS**

- A. Pursuant to its mandate, PFDA sustained the operation of the eight (8) Regional Fish Port Complexes (RFPCs) and one (1) Municipal Fish Port (MFP).
- B. From January to December 2014, the total volume of fish unloaded at the regional fish port complexes maintained by PFDA reached a total of 441,249 metric tons (mt), an 8% increase compared to last year's total of 406,850. General Santos and Navotas Fish Port Complexes were the two (2) biggest contributors to fish unloadings. Of the total, 44% was handled by the General Santos Fish Port Complex (GSFPC), 40% by Navotas Fish Port Complex (NFPC) while the remaining 16% was contributed by the other five (5) regional fish port complexes. There was no fish unloading in Camaligan Fish Port (CFP). Total number of fishing and non-fishing vessel arrivals reached 63,047, a 1% increase compared to last year's total of 62,233 and 15% higher compared to the set target of 54,850.
- C. Insofar as processing activity is concerned, 1,888 mt of fishery products were processed in Zamboanga, General Santos, Camaligan and Davao Fish Port Complexes. Moreover, the total volume of ice produced at the five (5) RFPCs was recorded at 44,799 mt., a 5% decrease compared to last year's total of 47,257 m.t.
- D. Volume of fish unloaded and transshipped at Infanta Municipal Fish Port in Quezon reached 3,295 mt, a 3% decrease compared to last year's record of 3,392 mt. and 8% below the set target of 3,577 mt. On the other hand, commercial and municipal fishing vessel arrivals reached 1,150.
- E. To date, a total of eighty (80) MFPs have been turned-over to LGUs nationwide and one (1) newly constructed fish port located in Tacloban, Leyte is for joint management by PFDA and Local Government Unit (LGU).

### **II. ON THE OPERATION OF THE ICE PLANT AND COLD STORAGE (IPCS) PROJECT**

In line with the government's privatization scheme, PFDA continued to lease out six (6) ice plants and cold storages to the private sector.
