HIGHLIGHTS OF ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT First Semester, 2019

Hereunder are the highlights of our Agency's accomplishments for the period January to June 2019:

I. ON THE OPERATION OF THE REGIONAL FISH PORT COMPLEXES AND MUNICIPAL FISH PORT

- A. Pursuant to its mandate, PFDA sustained the operation of the eight (8) Regional Fish Ports (RFPs) and one (1) Municipal Fish Port (MFP) jointly managed by PFDA and LGU.
- B. For the first semester of 2019, the total volume of fish unloaded at the regional fish port complexes maintained by PFDA reached a total of 282,199 metric tons (mt). The Navotas and General Santos Fish Port Complexes were the two (2) biggest contributors to fish unloadings. Of the total, 46% was handled by Navotas Fish Port Complex (NFPC), 42% by General Santos Fish Port Complex (GSFPC), while the remaining 12% was contributed by the other six (6) regional fish ports. Total number of fishing and non-fishing vessel arrivals reached 26,546.
- C. Insofar as processing activity is concerned, 776 mt of fishery products were processed inside the port's refrigeration facility of General Santos, Zamboanga and Camaligan Fish Ports. Moreover, the total volume of ice produced at the five (5) RFPs was recorded at 14,456 mt.
- D. To date, a total of 133 fish ports were constructed/rehabilitated/improved by the PFDA nationwide.

II. ON THE OPERATION OF THE ICE PLANT AND COLD STORAGE (IPCS) PROJECT

In line with the government's privatization scheme, PFDA continued to lease out four (4) ice plants and cold storages to the private sector located in the provinces of Masbate, Negros Occidental, Sultan Kudarat and Surigao del Norte.

III. ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE POST-HARVEST AND OTHER INFRASTRUCTURE COMPONENT:

- 11. Repair/Rehabilitation/Improvement of facilities of the Sual Fish Port (SFP), Sual, Pangasinan
- B. On-going projects:
 - 1. Construction of Mariveles Fish Port, Brgy. Pob., Mariveles, Bataan;
 - 2. Construction of Basay Fish Port, Brgy. Poblacion, Basay, Negros Oriental;
 - 3. Construction of Dolores Fish Port, Brgy. Poblacion 4, Dolores, Eastern Samar;
 - 4. Construction of Sta. Monica Fish Port, Brgy. T. Arlan, Sta. Monica, Surigao del Norte
 - 5. Construction of Tandag Fish Port, Brgy. Bongtub, Tandag City, Surigao del Sur;
 - 6. Upgrading of pier and repair of building facilities of ZFPC, Zamboanga City;
 - 7. Construction of Real Fish Port (Phase 2), Brgy. Ungos, Real Quezon;
 - 8. Repair/Rehabilitation/Improvement of facilities of NFPC;

- D. Preparation of Detailed Engineering Studies (DES) for the proposed construction of Balamban Fish Port & IPCS in Brgy. Poblacion, Balamban, Cebu is on-going.
- E. Pre-Feasibility (Pre-FS) Studies for the proposed projects are completed in the following:
 - 1. Establishment of Caoayan IPCS, Brgy Pandan, Caoayan, Ilocos Sur;
 - 2. Construction of Abulug Fish Port, Abulug Cagayan;
 - 3. Construction of Oroquieta City Fish Port, Misamis Occidental; and
 - 4. Construction of Lopez Jaena Fish Port, Misamis Occidental.

IV. ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF FLAGSHIP PROJECTS:

- A. The preparation of the Detailed Engineering Design for the rehabilitation and improvement of the three (3) Regional Fish Port Complexes, namely the Iloilo Fish Port Complex; Lucena Fish Port Complex; and Davao Fish Port Complex are on-going.
- B. The preparation of Detailed Engineering Design for the rehabilitation/improvement of Zamboanga Fish Port Complex is for issuance of Notice of Award.
- C. The pre-procurement of consultancy services for detailed engineering design for the rehabilitation/upgrading of the Navotas Fish Port Complex is yet to be scheduled.
