



Sealing and Marking of Bids  The original and the number of copies of the Bid as indicated in the <b>BDS</b> shall be typed or written in ink and shall be signed by the Bidder or its duly authorized representative/s.  All envelopes shall: (a) contain the name of the contract to be bid in capital letters; (b) bear the name and address of the Bidder in capital letters; (c) be addressed to the Procuring Entity's BAC in accordance with <b>ITB</b> Clause 21; (d) bear the specific identification of this bidding process indicated in the <b>ITB</b> Clause 1.2; and (e) bear a warning "DO NOT OPEN BEFORE..." the date and time for the opening of bids, in accordance with <b>ITB</b> Clause 21.  Bid envelopes that are not properly sealed and marked, as required in the bidding documents, shall not be rejected, but the Bidder or its duly authorized representative shall acknowledge such condition of the bid as submitted. The BAC or the Procuring Entity shall assume no responsibility for the misplacement of the contents of the improperly
