Interested bidders may submit their Letter of Intent (LOI) at the Office of the Bids and Awards Committee upon presentation of the original or authenticated renewal of contractor's license on the dates specified below. Prospective bidders should have key personnel and equipment (listed in the personnel and equipment requirements) available for the implementation of the contract and must have an experience or completed a contract that is similar to the contract to be bid of at least 50% of the ABC.

All particulars relative to bid security, performance security, pre-bidding conference, evaluation of bids, post-qualification and award of contract shall be governed by the pertinent provisions of R.A. 9184 and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.
