The Philippine Fisheries Development Authority - Navotas Fish Port Complex (PFDA-NFPC), through the Corporate Budget for CY 2021 intends to apply the sum of Three Million Ninety Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\$ 3,090,000.00), corresponding to each lot, and the Procurement Project/identification number of contract for each lot being the ABC to payments under the contract for each lot. Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

- 2. The PFDA-NFPC now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods for all lots are required thirty (30) calendar days from the receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP). Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
 - Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.
- 4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from PFDA-NFPC and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours from Monday to Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on November 10, 2021 from the given address below upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\$ 5,000.00) exclusive of VAT. The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees to be presented in person.

NOTE: For lot procurement, the maximum fee for the Bidding Documents for each lot shall be based on its ABC, in accordance with the Guidelines issued by the GPPB; provided that the total fees for the Bidding Documents of all lots shall not exceed the maximum fee prescribed in the Guidelines for the sum of the ABC of all lots.

6. The PFDA-NFPC will hold a Pre-Bid Conference¹ on November 19, 2021, 2:00 P.M at the Ground Floor PFDA GAD Building, Navotas Fish Port Complex, Navotas City

and through video conferencing or webcasting which shall be open to prospective bidders.

- Bids must be duly received by the RBAC Secretariat by manual submission at Ground Floor, PFDA GAD Center, Navotas Fish Port Complex, Navotas City on or before 12:00 noon, December 2, 2021. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.
- 9. Bid opening shall be on December 2, 2021, 2:00 P.M. at the Ground Floor, PFDA GAD Building, Navotas Fish Port Complex, NavotaS City and videoconferencing or webcasting. In observance with the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease protocol on social distancing, only one (1) designated/authorized representative per company shall be allowed to physically participate and/or attend in the conduct of the bidding activities. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
- 10. The PFDA-NFPC reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
