Dear Secretary Alcala and GM Javier,

This refers to your letter dated 20 January 2016, submitting the documentary requirements for the Business Unit (BU) Scoping in line with the proposed Compensation and Position Classification System (CPCS).

The PHILIPPINE FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (PFDA) shall be classified by its overall size based on the average grade on the following three (3) factors:

- (a) Company Financials;
- (b) Number of Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Employees; and
- (c) Geographical Scope and Business Complexity.

Based on the foregoing, this is to certify that the PFDA has been classified as a Grade 18 GOCC. Annex A presents the detailed evaluation in determining the PFDA's classification. The BU Grade shall serve as basis for the job leveling process of the GOCC.
