<u>Project Description</u>: Through this project, the Agency aims to gauge the employees' level of contentment toward their jobs and their level of understanding and appreciation of the corporate nandate, vision and goals. The ESS also seeks to assess the employees' motivation and involvement relative to the implementation of the agency's programs and provisions for employee welfare.

In the process, the survey shall identify the issues and factors that affect employee satisfaction and the areas of agency programs that employees perceive as areas for improvement, particularly those that pertain to the growth and development of employees.

To ensure proper assessment and validation of the survey results, the project team shall employ methodologies such as focus group discussions and interviews with employee-respondents both in the Central Office and operating units.

<u>Project Status:</u> The following activities pertinent to the development of the agency rationalization plan were conducted during the period covering the third quarter of CY 2015:

- Consolidation of initial unit submissions and presentation of salient ARP information during the second quarter managers' meeting (July 29-30, 2015)
- Preparation of the pertinent ARP-related materials for the PFDA Change Management Team (CMT) deliberations specifically with regard to the following considerations;
 - Identification of positions for standardization across all units (Central office and regional fish ports/operating units)

Clustering of proposed positions into job families

 Preliminary determination of job families for retention, reclassification and abolition based on identified corporate strategic objectives
